Dear Volunteer,

Camp Mennoscah has been notified that on April 18, 2019, Luke Loganbill was charged with child sexual abuse for incidents occurring in Goodwell, Oklahoma between August 1, 2016, and May 31, 2017. Also, on June 5, 2019, Luke was charged with sexual battery for incidents occurring in Guymon, Oklahoma in December 2017. Prior to the time period these alleged offenses took place, Luke Loganbill volunteered as a co-counselor at Camp Mennoscah for the camp weeks of PreJunior I (June 12-16), PreJunior II (June 26-30), and First Camp (July 7-9), in the summer of 2016.

We are sharing this information with you because, according to our records, served as a volunteer or staff person for one of those weeks. At this time, Camp Mennoscah has not received information or complaints of any incidents involving Luke Loganbill taking place at Camp Mennoscah.

We believe that Camp Mennoscah should be a safe place for all campers who attend summer youth camps and require the following steps to reduce the risk of abuse and misconduct: two staff persons present where campers are present, two counselors assigned to each cabin group, background checks (including sex offenders registry) for all staff and volunteers, reference checks, and Abuse Prevention training for all staff and volunteers. These steps were in place prior to the summer of 2016 and are required of all staff and volunteers on a yearly basis.

Camp Mennoscah remains committed to supporting victims of abuse, and while we have not received information or complaints of any incidents involving Luke Loganbill at camp, if you had a concerning experience with Luke Loganbill at Camp Mennoscah, please contact Executive Director Michael Unruh or Board of Directors President Kevin Wilder (contact information below) as well as the proper authority: for incidents involving persons under age 18, the Kansas Protection Report Center, 1-800-922-5330, and for persons over age 18, law enforcement. Any incidents disclosed to Camp Mennoscah will be reported to the proper authorities.
